RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS

1. Please provide the CADD Files

ANSWER: CAD files will be provided to the selected contractor after contract award. Refer to General Note 2 on Drawing 008-G-0005.

2. Is the contractor responsible for locating any existing utilities

ANSWER: Refer to Drawing 008-G-0003 Notes G-6 and G-8 for contractor's responsibilities regarding locations and protection of existing utilities. Other drawing notes, and technical specifications may also be relevant.

3. Plan sheet 52 of 55 shows a typical collar detail, does JAXPORT have a rebar table showing how many pounds per cy Is required for these collar repairs?

ANSWER: Collar details show the required reinforcement, as is normal practice. It is the contractor's responsibility to determine volume or weight of steel.

4. Sheet 25 and 26. The Area the east of the phase 8 which goes beyond the project limits is where note#3 is referring to. Does the contractor need to carry costs for water blasting thermoplastic pavement markings that will be placed in the current construction phase?

ANSWER: In order to create a holistic terminal for all phases, the contractor will be required to remove pavement markings installed in the phases presently under construction, as shown on Drawings 008-C-2702 and 008-C-2703. The specific needs shall be coordinated with the Construction Manager who is managing both contracts.

5. Sheet 22 of 55. Keeping Center Street open to heavy truck traffic on the narrow roadway will require heavy shoring. Will an MOT Plan be provided? Can Center be closed and all traffic use Container Way while under construction or is this to be a phased crossing?

ANSWER: It is confirmed that the contractor will need to stabilize Center Street when working close to the western boundary of Phase 8. As noted in Specification Section 01-50-00 TEMPORARY FACILITIES AND CONTROLS, contractor shall submit Traffic Control Plan and Traffic Routing Plan to Construction Manager for approval. Center Street is to remain open during operational hours.

6. Please provide a typical drawing for roadway repair for storm drain crossings and/or tie-ins which fall outside this project's limits.

ANSWER: Existing pavement section is currently unknown for areas beyond the limits of Phase 8. Please refer to Bid Reference Documents A and B for geotechnical information and borings. For the purposes of the bid, contractor shall assume 2" thick asphalt and 11" thick limerock base for the repair of any trenches extending beyond the Phase 8 boundary. Details of trench repairs are shown on Drawing 008-C-5802.

7. Please provide a typical (detail) for fence requirements in areas where storm drainage crosses over the project limits (i.e., Remove/reset existing; remove/replace new).

ANSWER: Where work is required beyond the limits of Phase 8, existing fence shall be removed, protected, and reinstalled. Any fence that is damaged shall be repaired to the satisfaction of the Construction Manager, or replaced with new, either being at the contractor's expense. Typical fence details are shown on Drawings 008-C-5302 and 008-C-5303.

8. Is Bid Item D6 and D9 a duplicate?

ANSWER: Bid Item D6 should read "Demolition and Disposal of Utility Pipe including Drainage, Sanitary, Fire, and Water." Bid Item D9 should read "Demolition and Disposal of Utility Conduit/ Ductbank Including Electrical and Communications." Please see revised bid form (rev.1), attached.

9. Can the question period be extended? If not, can the bid proposal date be moved up?

ANSWER: Bid questions will be extended to Tuesday, 9 May 2023 at 12:00. Additional questions received after this date will not be responded to.

10. Is the intention to have the Fire & Water Mains out of service, as we install the new lines within the exact same footprint? It would be a 2 week outage.

ANSWER: Contractor shall identify and locate all valves on fire and potable water lines, which form loops on Blount Island Marine Terminal, based on information to be provided by JAXPORT after award of contract. Valves may be closed to isolate the pipes to be demolished while allowing flow of fire or potable water in active loops. Contractor shall plan loop closures with the Construction Manager, SSA and JAXPORT.

- 11. Detail 2 of drawing 44 shows the electrical equipment mounting between the hand holes and the HMLP. Based on the current project the physical constraints of the space will make this physically impossible as shown without routing conduits out and around all of the obstructions with the steel bollards and the HMLP structure. Are we to assume that the conduits can be installed as shown for estimation purposes or include additional footage of duct-bank that will be required? **ANSWER:** Routing of conduits at each HMLP is shown on Drawing 008-C-4001. Nonetheless, there is a physical space constraint at HMLP #16 which is resolved on the attached revised Drawings. Refer to 008-C-2802 REV1, 008-C-4001 REV1 and 008-E-1001 REV3.
- 12. The electrical one line is dependent on the electrical distribution of the current phase being complete and ready for the new conductors. Will this schedule for this project reflect that project and its completion date?

ANSWER: The 'Phases 1 to 7 Contractor' will install conduits from the eastern boundary of Phase 8 to the Distribution Panel YLDP as shown on Drawing 008-E-1001. It is presently scheduled that these conduits will be completed by middle of June 2023 in Phase 4. YLDP will be installed in Phase 5 and installation dates have not been finalized. The selected Phase 8 contractor shall install the conductor connecting YLPB to YLDP as stated in response to Q.14. Scheduling of activities between 'Phases 1 to 7 Contractor' and 'Phase 8 Contractor' are expected to be compatible and will be coordinated by the Construction Manager.

13. The drawings reference using existing conduits installed in a previous phase. Based on other projects at the port if we are to encounter a conduit collapse in existing raceways who will be the responsible party for repairs? Are we to include camera scoping existing conduits and mandril of them to proof the conduits prior to pulling cable?

ANSWER: The Construction Manager will independently determine the reason for the perceived collapse and assign responsibility accordingly. However, as all conduits will be installed new, then the contractor responsible for the installation shall be responsible for ensuring they are clear.

Drawing 44 of 5 shows (2) sets of (3) 500 copper conductors going north from the airport-rated manhole. What is the termination point of these conductors?
ANSWER: Drawing 008-E-6001 shows the feeder connects YLDP to YLPB. For clarity, YLPB is to be installed in Phase 8 adjacent to HMLP #16. YLDP is to be installed in other existing contract

(Phase 1 to 7) as shown on Drawing 008-E-1001.

15. Is the new restroom building a single-point connection?

ANSWER: The restroom will have incoming potable water and power, and outgoing wastewater. The wastewater will connect to the lift station. Pipes are shown on Drawing 008-C-2803 and power is shown on Drawing 008-E-1001.

16. Is the new lift station a single-point connection?

ANSWER: The lift station has two incoming lines, one from the restroom and one from the new sanitary manhole near the existing substation. The outlet of the lift station will connect to the existing sanitary force main. Pipes are shown on Drawing 008-C-2803 and power is shown on Drawing 008-E-1001.

If provided with a Notice of Intent to Award the Contract by the Owner, the Bidder shall execute and deliver to the Owner all of the documents required by the Contract Documents, including but not limited to, the Contract Agreement and the Performance and Payment Bonds in the form contained in the Contract Documents, furnish the required evidence of the specified insurance coverages, furnish all necessary permits, licenses, materials, equipment, machinery, maintenance, tools, apparatus, means of transportation and labor necessary to complete the Work provided for in the Contract Documents for **C-1772A**.

If the Bidder improperly withdraws its Bid or fails to execute and deliver to the Owner any of the documents required by the Contract Documents, within ten (10) days after the date of the Notice of Intent to Award, the Owner may seek recourse against the Bid Security as provided for in the Contract Documents.

The Bidder shall commence work specified herein within the time limits set forth in the General Provisions, which time limits the Bidder acknowledges are reasonable. If the Bidder fails to complete the Work within the scheduled time or any authorized extension thereof, Liquidated Damages, in accordance with the Contract Documents, shall be deducted from the Total Contract Price.
