Item No. 01

Reference to **Bid Form, Pages BF-1 to BF-3**, **DELETE** in its entirety and **REPLACE** with **REVISED Bid Form, Pages BF-1 to BF-3** referenced as "Attachment No. 03". (Changes highlighted in "red" for ease of review).

Item No. 02

Clarification to Owner's Option - Bid Form: During the Pre-bid meeting, it was stated that the dollar amount for the Owner's Option ("Item 4") would be a full substitution of "Item 2" of Bid Form. A decision has been made to change that statement as follows:

The dollar amount for the Owner's Option shall be only the price to upgrade the luminaries from "Type A" to "Type A1". This is, "Item 4" shall be ONLY the difference in price due to furnishing and installing luminaries "Type A1", instead of luminaries "Type A". If JAXPORT decides to execute the Owner's Option, the amount to be paid will be "Item 2" plus "Item 4". (See Attachment No. 03)

ANSWER: The project is Sheltered for 100% Participation of certified SEB companies JSEB/WBE/DBE/SBA. The Authority reserves the right to award this contract to the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder, and whose bid is fully conforming to the requirements of the bid documents.

2. Is the irrigation meter currently installed at the cruise terminal for the upcoming project, or will the contractor be required to obtain one from JEA?

ANSWER: Meter to be obtained / installed by Contractor (see last item of "Material Legend" on Sheet "IR-1", and note next to meter symbol on Sheet "IR-4" of project drawings).

3. Is a City of Jax ROW Permit or FDOT ROW permit required?

ANSWER: A COJ <u>ROW</u> Permit is not required. JAXPORT has obtained an FDOT Permit.

4. Is a DCPS Certification acceptable?

ANSWER: Yes, DCPS SBE, MBE, and M/WBE Certification are acceptable.
