OPERATION OF CRUISE SHIP PARKING FACILITIES (RE-BID) FOR THE JACKSONVILLE PORT AUTHORITY

RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS

1. How much is the current hourly rate on the Buck Island Site?

ANSWER: The hourly rate is \$16.20.

2. Please identify the average monthly hours worked on the Buck Island Site?

ANSWER: Within a 6-month time period, the average monthly hours worked is 110.86.

3. Please confirm the average number of cars on each cruise?

ANSWER: The average number of cars is 425.

4. On average, how many vehicles pre-purchase parking?

ANSWER: The average number of pre-purchase parking is 200.

5. How much is the current annual management fee with the current contractor?

ANSWER: The current "per cruise" management fee is \$1,489.49 and the ship operates approximately seventy-eight (78) cruises a year.

6. Can JAXPORT hold a Cruise Parking Site Visit on a cruise day along with a Site Visit to Buck Island?

ANSWER: Optional Site Visit of the CRUISE TERMINAL PARKING AREA will be held on Monday, October 17, 2022 at 9:30AM. BUCK ISLAND area can be view at your convenience (see addendum cover for more details).

7. Please confirm that insurance coverage is necessary for any golf carts used as part of operating the cruise parking.

ANSWER: Confirmed — Vendor is required to provide evidence of Business Auto Policy ISO Form Number CA 00 01 and endorsed for CA 04 45 Golf Carts and Low-Speed Vehicles with limits no less than \$1,000,000 per accident, bodily injury, and property damage. Policy must be primary and non-contributory. A waiver of subrogation is required for workers' compensation, commercial general liability, and auto liability.

8. For the purposes of calculating insurance premiums, please confirm the space count to be insured.

ANSWER: Cruise Terminal Parking has 607 paid striped parking spaces and the JAXPORT's Employees Parking Lot could be used for overflow, which is 173 additional striped parking spaces.
