# CEO's Update

Mr. Paul Anderson thanked Sr. Director of Trade Development and Global Marketing Raul Alfonso and his staff for traveling to meet with customers and potential clients, including the recent Brazil trip with Governor Rick Scott and Mayor Alvin Brown.

After providing an update on the Mile Point project, he stated that we are competing vigorously for businesses and we are changing the process in the way projects are being done. Mr. Anderson also stated that the JAXPORT brand is good, strong, and growing. Mr. Anderson spoke last Wednesday before the House of Representatives Sub-Committee on Water Resources and the Environment on the importance of seaports. It went well and many questions were asked including how do we change the process? His submitted testimony resonated with not only members of the committee and staff, which is very important, but also stated that we are writing a transportation reauthorization bill and think many of our recommendations will be incorporated in language of that bill.

Mr. Anderson stated that he is working closely with Mayor Alvin Brown, who was recently appointed to the Ports Task Force for the US Conference of Mayors. Mr. Anderson thinks that is a good appointment for Mayor Brown because it will allow him to have a national voice and he will be able to project the JAXPORT brand to his colleagues. Last Friday, Mr. Anderson had the opportunity to meet with Tom Cochran, President and CEO of the US Conference of Mayors, while he was in town for the FL/GA game. Mayor Brown and Mr. Cochran have made ports their top priority. Mr. Anderson stated that he will continue to work closely with Mayor Brown and will provide him with information and make some introductions for him to try and build some coalitions with the American Association of Port Authorities and other industries and associations that are promoting ports before the U.S. Congress.

Mr. Anderson also stated that the TRAPAC grant was completed successfully.
