New Business

BD2017-08-01 Joint Participation Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for Blount Island & Talleyrand Marine Terminal

Mr. Mike Poole presented this submission for Board approval of a joint participation agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for improvements at Blount Island and Talleyrand Marine Terminals.

After a motion was made by Dr. Newman and a second by Mr. York, the Board voted unanimously to approve this submission.

BD2017-08-02 External Auditor

Mr. Mike Poole presented this submission for Board approval of a contract with Certified Public Accounting firm RSM, US, LLP for external auditing services.

After a motion was made by Mr. Fleming and a second by Mr. York, the Board voted unanimously to approve this submission.

Interim CEO Report

Mr. Green stated that the port has received a good endorsement on our harbor deepening project from the Florida Times Union Editorial Board which a tremendous milestone for us. He stated that we also received a commitment from the Mayor, and Mr. Green wanted to thank him publicly for his commitment towards our project as we continue to move forward and work with him and his team.

Mr. Green stated that about a week ago he took the port's budget to the Finance Committee, and he was successful in moving the port's budget through the Finance Committee after about an hour and a half of debate and discussion. He looks forward to JAXPORT's budget moving on to the full City Council and being voted on at the end of September.

Mr. Green stated that last Wednesday he was accompanied by Mr. Falconetti and they traveled to Washington, D.C. to meet with the decision makers as it pertains to funding. He stated that they had a very good discussion with the USACE at their headquarters. Mr. Green thinks it was a successful meeting in getting a better understanding of where the funding lies and where it is headed. There was no commitment of funding, but he thinks the meeting went well.

Mr. Falconetti stated that he felt encouraged and more optimistic than ever that we have a great partnership with the federal government and the USACE and the current administration. He thought it was a great meeting as well.

Mr. Green informed the Board that he would be traveling to Cocoa Beach today along with David Kaufman and Mike Poole to attend the Florida Ports Council Fall Board meeting where all of the Florida ports will be represented. There will be lots of discussion at this meeting about the annual appropriation that is received from the State Legislature to the Florida Ports Council, so he is hoping to come back with funds that help the port on the capital side of the house. He will proceed from Cocoa Beach over to Orlando to fly back to D.C. Mr. Green received a special invitation from the White House to attend a presentation and roundtable discussion with U.S. Secretary of Transportation, Elaine Chao, Mr. Mick Mulvaney, who is the OMB Director, and Mr. D.J. Gribbin, who is a Special Assistant to the President for Infrastructure Policy. He stated that JAXPORT is one of only two ports that have received this invitation and he is looking forward to attending this meeting.

Mr. Green then introduced JAXPORT's new in-house counsel Mr. Gilbert Feltel. He also thanked Board Member Joe York for sitting on the evaluation committee regarding this position.
