Jacksonville is one of the nation's busiest ports for total vehicle handling. Last year, JAXPORT moved more than 652,000 vehicles.

THREE MAJOR AUTO PROCESSORS ON PORT TERMINALS

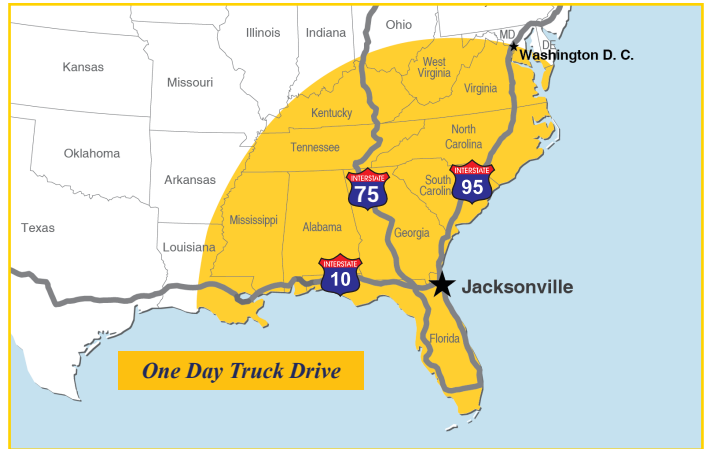

CLOSE PROXIMITY - SHIP BERTHS TO POINT OF REST

Jacksonville's port has auto processing facilities as close as 100 yards from ship berths, with all storage on terminal.
