### FAST REACH

Florida is now the nation's third most populous state – and more than 98 million U.S. consumers live within a one-day truck drive of Jacksonville's port.

### GLOBAL CONNECTIONS

JAXPORT offers worldwide cargo service from dozens of ocean carriers, including direct service with Asia, Europe, Africa, South America, the Caribbean and other key markets.

### OUTSTANDING INTERMODAL

JAXPORT terminals integrate with three U.S. interstates (I-10, I-95 and I-75), 40 daily trains via Class I rail lines CSX and Norfolk Southern, regional line Florida East Coast Railway and near-dock and on-dock rail providers.

### NOW DEEPENING

The Jacksonville Harbor Deepening Project is anticipated to be complete before the end of 2022, three years ahead of its original schedule. The project will deepen the shipping channel to 47 feet offering the largest container ships calling the US East Coast unobstructed access to port terminals.

### BALANCED IMPORTS/EXPORTS

The port's equal balance of imports and exports provides backhaul opportunities, saving money and maximizing transportation costs.

### ROOM TO GROW

Northeast Florida has 144 million square feet of distribution center and warehousing space within close proximity to the port.
